



"When should I start potty training my child?" This is a question posed to many parenting professionals. Of course each child differs in their readiness; but some general tips include: 1. Wait until your child is at least 2 years old; 2. Frequently allow your child to watch you go to the bathroom; 3. Make sure both you and your child are ready; 4. Let your child practice on a potty chair, with clothes on; 5. Prompt your child – tell, don't ask; 6. Postpone toilet training for a few weeks if it isn't going well or if you are getting tense about it; 7. Expect accidents; 8. If your child has a lot of accidents or if you must use intensive toilet training, ask your health care provider for the guidelines on positive practice; 9. Praise your child every time he or she does any part of toileting behavior correctly.

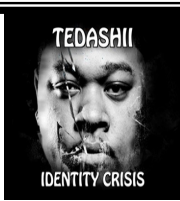
