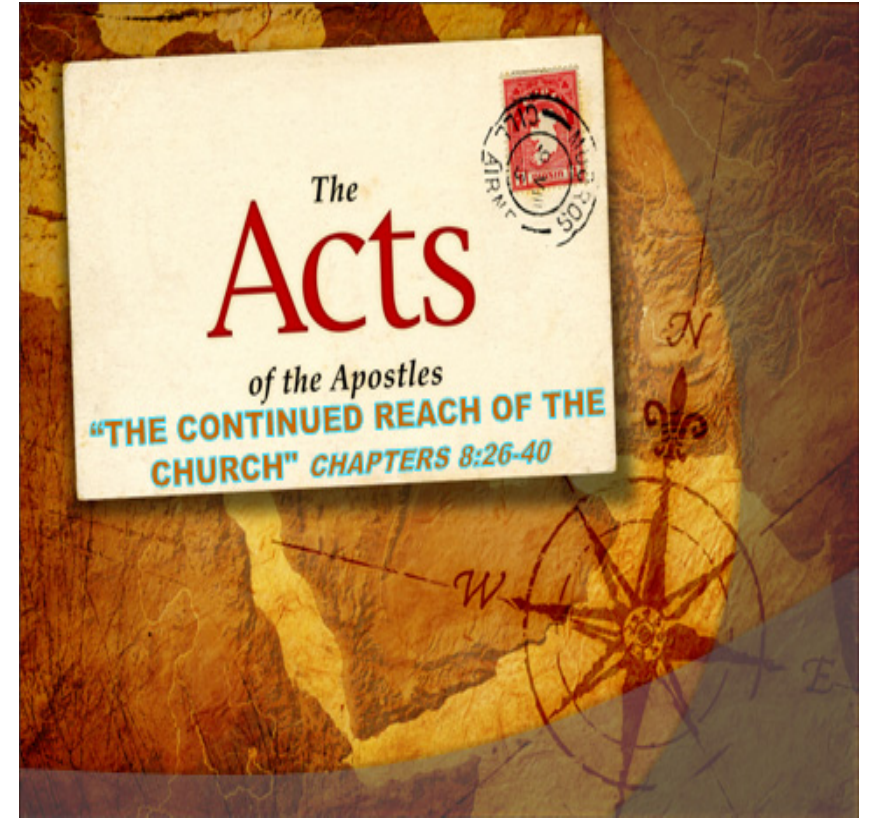

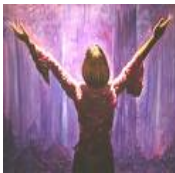


The Church picnic is Saturday, August 22. Look for details in the bulletin. Chris and Kim Brooks are the organizers of this event.
